(i) Financial Capability

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s):

1. Financial Performance

Bidder shall submit last three (3) years Audited Financial Statements which shall include balance sheets, profit and loss statements, cash flow statements and Auditor's Reports and must demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's financial position and indicate its prospective long-term profitability.

2. Average Annual Turnover

Bidder shall have minimum average annual sales revenue (turnover) over the last three (3) years of not less than **Ten million US Dollars** (US\$10m)

(ii) Experience and Technical Capacity

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s):

- a. The bidder shall have been engaged in the business of extracting 2D and 3D building footprints from high resolution satellite imagery (50 cm resolution or better) at the scale of entire countries and delivering derived products together with underlying imagery as needed for at least five (5) years supported with documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business.
- b. The bidder shall demonstrate access to archive or newly tasked imagery suitable for stereo production over Nigeria to a degree that would allow delivering imagery for at least 80% of the area of Nigerian states in a 6 month window.
- c. The bidder shall provide at least three examples (of at least 50 km²) of vector data, digital terrain models, and orthophotos produced similar to the specifications in this contract, preferably from different regions.

- d. The bidder shall demonstrate the capacity of extracting vector data of the type required from high resolution imagery at a rate of that would allow delivery of final products within the specified timeline.
- e. The bidder shall demonstrate that the items by the manufacturers must have been in successful operation for at least five (5) years.

(iii) Documentary Evidence

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that the Goods it offers meet the following usage requirement:

Payment of foreign currency portion shall be made in *currency of the Contract Price* in the following manner:

- (i) Advance Payment: Ten (10) percent of the Contract Price shall be paid within thirty (30) days of signing of the Contract, and upon submission of claim and a bank guarantee for equivalent amount valid until the Goods are delivered and in the form provided in the bidding document or another form acceptable to the Purchaser.
- (ii) **On Delivery:** Eighty (80) percent of the Contract Price of the Goods shipped shall be paid through irrevocable confirmed letter of credit opened in favor of the Supplier in a bank in its country, upon submission of documents specified in GCC Clause 13.
- (iii) On Acceptance: Ten (10) percent of the Contract Price of Goods received shall be paid within thirty (30) days of receipt of the Goods upon submission of claim supported by the acceptance certificate issued by the Purchaser.

Payment of local currency portion shall be made in <u>Nigeria Naira</u> within thirty (30) days of presentation of claim supported by a certificate from the Purchaser declaring that the Goods have been delivered and that all other contracted Services have been performed.
