The Federal Government of Nigeria has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the States Fiscal Transparency, Accountability and Sustainability (SFTAS) Program for Results, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include providing technical support to the OGP-SFTAS team to support them to successfully implement the OGP workplan for the SFTAS Program.

The Federal Ministry of Finance, Home Finance Department now invites eligible individual consultants (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- Minimum Masters’ Degree in any Management or Social Science Field such as Economics, Public Administration, Political Science, Public Policy, International Relations or Development Studies;
- Minimum of eight (8) years cognate experience in project management and coordination, public or private sector experience working in multi-sectoral team will be an added advantage;
- Computer literacy - demonstrable proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Excel and PowerPoint);
- Fluency in English Language;
- Strong communication skills - written and verbal. The incumbent should be able to demonstrate a strong command of all forms of communication and relay messages in a consistently effective, timely and engaging manner;
- Excellent and demonstrable leadership and management skills will be required.
